This is a full-time, nonexempt position reporting to the Program Manager and based in San Jose with frequent travel throughout Santa Clara County.

- Outreach to potential applicants on the street, initial intakes, and support residents through housing process
- Provide clinical case management services, including rehabilitative services, brokerage, collateral, and therapy to participants in community based settings utilizing Assertive Community Treatment model
- Complete assessments, treatments plans, on-going mental status exams, safety assessments, facilitate psycho-educational and support groups
- Develop relationships with community agencies providing housing and supportive services
- Participate in clinical, administrative, and case conferencing meetings
- Ensure proper and timely documentation of services and data, including written case notes in BIRP formats, and billing services to Medi-Cal

How You Meet the Qualifications:

- MA degree in psychology, counseling, or social work from an accredited university
- Current registration with California Board of Behavioral Sciences as an ASW/MFTi is required (licensure is a plus)
- Ability for frequent travel by car throughout the county and surrounding regions. Must have reliable transportation, current California Driver's License, auto insurance, and clean DMV record is required
- 2 years of field experience working with people with serious mental illness, individuals with co-occurring disorders and complex health issues and/or the chronically homeless population
- Experience working within an Assertive Community Treatment program and working knowledge of Housing First, Motivational Interviewing, Harm Reduction, Psychosocial Rehabilitation, Psychiatric Disorders and Chemical Dependency Disorders, Crisis Intervention
- Mastery of Medi-Cal billing experience with strong writing skills for assessments, treatment plans, case notes, and able to meet billing deadlines

- Build supportive, respectful working relationships; cultural sensitivity through open dialogue and self-exploration with diverse groups
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills. Able to work independently and collaboratively as part of a team
- Must be willing and able to work Saturdays (1-2 times per month) and evenings (2-3 times per week)
- Flexibility for work hours, including some weekends and evenings
