ORGANIZATION SUMMARY

Abode Services believes that everyone should have a home. Since our founding in 1989, Abode has grown from a small organization sheltering a few dozen people in Fremont, California, to a \$34 million agency offering innovative, successful housing and services for more than 6,100 adults and children in Alameda, Santa Clara, San Mateo, Santa Cruz, and Napa counties each year.

Over the course of this growth, we have become a nationally recognized leader in evidence-based approaches to ending homelessness for those most in need, including Housing First, rapid re-housing, and supportive housing. We administer more than \$14 million in rental assistance each year, partnering with local cities and counties to place vulnerable people experiencing homelessness into housing, and help them maintain that housing by connecting them to supportive services.

The success of our approach shows in our program outcomes and effectiveness in helping people out of homelessness: on a given night, our programs maintain approximately 2,246 adults and children in housing, helping them avoid a return to homelessness.

7,534 individuals placed into permanent housing since 2010

FUNDING SOURCES
