- Working knowledge of Housing First, Motivational Interviewing, Harm Reduction, Psychosocial Rehabilitation, Psychiatric Disorders, Chemical Dependency Disorders, and Crisis Interventions

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- Strong clinical writing skills completing assessments, treatment plans, and mastery of Medi-Cal charting while meeting billing deadlines
- Must have ability for frequent travel by car throughout the county, current California Driver's License, auto insurance, and clean DMV record is required
